

High Level Covid Supervisor Bursary

The Production Guild of Great Britain and The British Film Commission are pleased to be able to offer bursaries to those who wish to pursue training in Covid management but would find this difficult because of their financial considerations.

Our focus is on supporting those who wish to become Covid supervisors or work within Covid management departments in the film and TV industry. Priority will be given to those who have experience of managing departments on set or with relevant transferrable skills.

Bursary amounts offered range from £100 - £400.

Eligibility

Your eligibility for a bursary is based on the following basic criteria:

- You currently work in the UK screen industries, or can demonstrate your intention to work in the UK screen industries
- You are eligible to work in the UK
- You are 18 years old or over

Considerations:

You can apply for either a full bursary covering the entire cost of the course or a partial bursary. Please specify on your application which you are applying for and, if applying for a partial bursary, how much you will need to undertake the course.

We will endeavour to support underrepresented groups within the screen industries to ensure the funding supports the industry's ambition to fully reflect the UK population in its workforce.

Your application checklist – please ensure:

- You have included a copy of your CV and a 500-word personal statement outlining how a bursary will make a difference to you and how you intend to use your training to contribute to the film and TV industry.
- Following a provisional offer, you must provide proof of ID and eligibility to work in the UK.
